- 1. Please advise how to get plans for the project?
  - Site plans will not be sent out to the bidders. All specifications for the equipment and services requested are posted in the RFP under "Desired Services" in page 9 of the RFP Packet
- 2. What addresses would we put for shipping?
  - The addresses for each location that will receive a new playground are posted in Attachment A of the RFP document Location Table found in page 21 of the RFP packet
- 3. How many playgrounds will you be needing
  - 1. IDEA Hope
  - 2. IDEA Victory
  - o 3. IDEA Plank Rd
- 4. All of the playgrounds will be just for ages 5-12?
  - Yes, all playgrounds are to be for ages 5-12. This information is shared under Desires Services in page 9 of the RFP packet.
- 5. May we get a complementary PDF copy of the documents (plans and specs) for this project?
  - All specifications for equipment can be found in the RFP document under Desired Services in page 9 of the RFP packet.
- 6. Estimate value
  - The budget for each location is \$130,000 which should cover playground equipment, safety surface, and installation. This information in shared under Desired Services in page 9 of the RFP packet.
  - In addition, see awarded vendor responsibilities below in question #8
- 7. Plan holders list?

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- IDEA Public Schools reserves the right to disclose bidder information
- 8. I see that the surfacing preference is PIP or turf and the size of the play area is 50 x 60. There is no mention of the

sub-base or containment area. Will the sub-base and curb work need to be part of the price for the turn-key project?

- The awarded bidder will be responsible for:
  - Providing the stone
  - Compacting the stone to 3.5" thick
  - Installing 2" of floor padding
  - Providing .5" of playground grass
  - Installing all playground equipment
  - The General Contractor at the sites will be responsible for:
    - Excavating the area (50'x60')
      - Installing drainage system either by connecting to the storm drainage system or providing weep holes on the concrete curb.
      - Compacting subgrade 6" deep
      - Form and pour the 6" wide x 12" deep concrete curb around the play area (contractor will make sure that from the top of the concrete curb we have a clearance of 6" to the top of the compacted subgrade.
- 9. Is concrete subgrade or compacted stone preferred?

Compacted stone is preferred

10. Will sun shelters/shades be required?

- $\circ$  Sun shelters/shades are a welcomed addition to your proposal, however they are not a requirement.
- 11. Are benches and signs part of the bid?
- $\circ$  Additions such as benches and signage are not part of the RFP.
- 12. Is there any particular equipment that is not allowed at IDEA?
- There are no non-negotiables on playground equipment. The playground should accommodate the widest possible range of activities that will provide fun, promote physical fitness, and encourage social interaction.
  13. Is there a preference for 3 1/2" vs a 5" post?
- There is no preference on post measurements.
- 14. Should shade be free standing or integrated?
