To: All Prospective Vendors

- Is the purpose of the RFP to create a list of approved vendor solutions or to select solution(s) for purchase?
 - o No, we want to find a vendor/s and purchase at district level for all our campuses.
- Would a fully online solution be acceptable?
 - Yes
- For pricing purposes, how many students are expected to use the solution? How many teachers need to be trained?
 - o Approximately 50,000+; Approximately 3,500 teachers
- Would IDEA like to see tiered pricing?
 - Yes
- What solution(s) is IDEA currently using?
 - o Imagine Learning, Dreambox, ST Math have been some district wide platforms we have used in the past.
- Would IDEA consider a math-only solution?
 - Ideally, we are looking for one vendor that could supply both, but are open to quality ELA and/or Math programs individually

- Please elaborate on the requirement on RFP page 6 for "Software programming company that has the ability to work with IDEA data team to correlate their program data with IDEA and state standard data."
 - o Any program we utilize, we want to see it's impact on State Assessments (STAAR, LEAP, TELPAS, ELPT, etc.) so we would love a vendor who can help us analyze data correlations.

- What information does IDEA expect vendors to provide in the Additional Requirements section of their proposals?
 - o Any additional documents, beside from required forms that vendor would like to include or believe would benefit the IDEA Special Programs team and their decision in selecting a vendor.
- In what section should vendors provide the required forms?
 - all required forms/documents can be attached to the attachments tab.
- Can a math only apply or must be provide both ELA and math?
 - We are willing to consider awarding separate contracts to vendors that only have Math or ELA.
- It states multiple languages, we only have Spanish, is that sufficient? Or were you looking at more languages?
 - Our main second language we require is Spanish, but as we are a national charter, we encounter a variety of languages so prefer a vendor that has a variety of different language supports.
- Is the intent of this RFP to make a list of approved vendors that schools can purchase from?
 - No, we want to find a vendor/s and purchase at district level for all our campuses.
- Are you only interested in programs that have both math and literacy in one program?
 - We will consider awards for quality vendors that offer only math or ELA but prefer one that does both.
- Are you only interested in programs that serve all grades K-12, or programs that serve a portion of the grades?
 - Looking to serve grades PK-8th primarily.
- The Items tab requests pricing in two areas Default Bid Group and Adaptive Literacy and Math Software. How should we fill this out? How many students should we base pricing on?
 - Approximately 50,000+
