

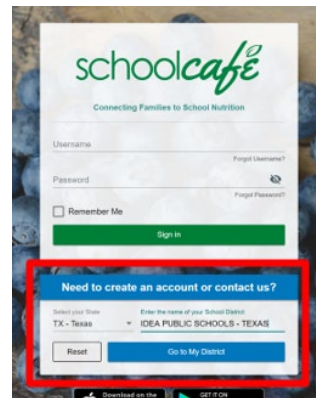


Student Meal Account Management on SchoolCafé

Welcome to IDEA Public Schools! Our schools offer healthy meals every school day and your student may qualify for free or reduced meals. To determine if your student qualifies for free or reduced meals, you will need to complete a free and reduced meal (FARM) application. The easiest and most convenient way to complete a FARM application is online through SchoolCafé. The following guide will help you 1) create a SchoolCafé account and 2) complete your meal application on SchoolCafé.

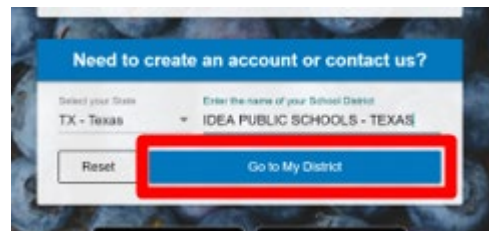
1) How to Create a School Café Account

Step 1: On a computer or laptop, go to www.schoolcafe.com.

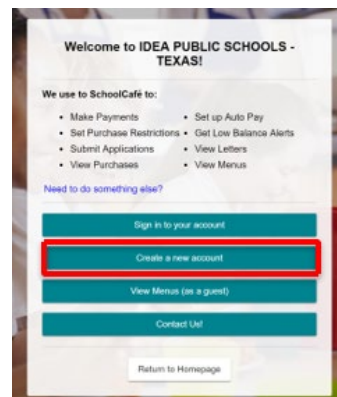


Step 2: Select state and enter IDEA Public Schools.

Step 3: Click on "Go to My District".



Step 4: On the next screen, click on "Create a new account".





Step 5: On the next screen, click on “I’m a Parent”. Then click “Next”.

Step 6: On the next screen, confirm your school district. Then click Next.

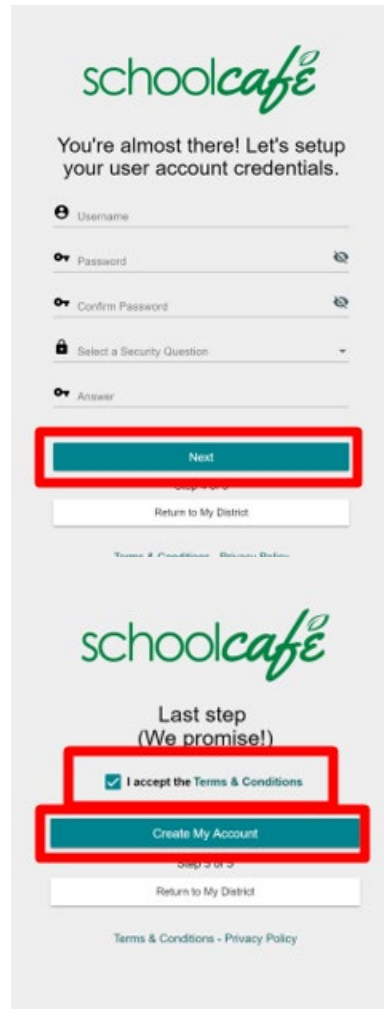

Step 7: On the next screen, enter your first name, last name, email, and phone number. Then click Next.

Step 8: On the next screen, enter username, password, and security question and answer. Then click Next.



Step 9: On the next screen, check off “I accept the Terms & Conditions”. Then click “Create My Account”.

You now have a School Café account!

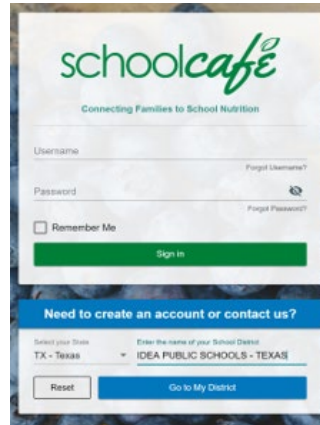

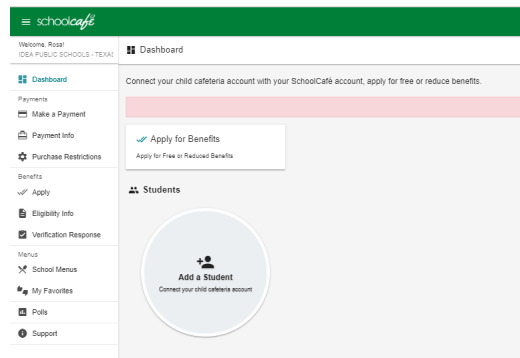
Now that you have created a SchoolCafé account, you can login into SchoolCafé and complete your student's meal application.

2) How to Apply for Meal Benefits

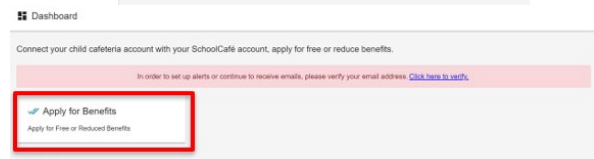
Step 1: On a computer or laptop, go to www.schoolcafe.com.



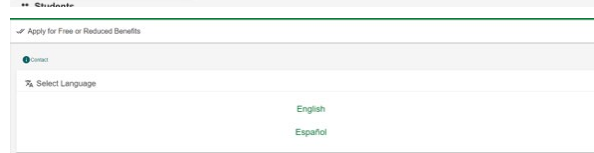
Step 2: After logging in to SchoolCafé, you will see the Dashboard.



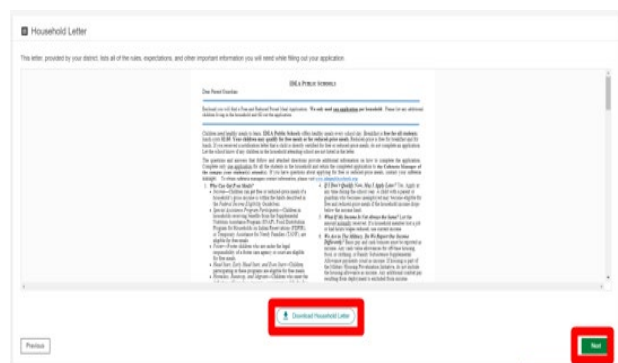
Step 3: Click on “Apply for Benefits”.



Step 4: On the next screen, select your preferred language.



Step 5: Review the Letter to the Household. You can download the letter to keep a copy for your files or click Next to continue.





Step 6: On the next screen, enter the applicant information is shown. The applicant is the parent/guardian who is completing the application. If everything is correct, click “Save Applicant Information”.

Step 7: Check off certification box. Then click Next.

Step 8: On the next screen, you will add the student to the meal application. Click “Add a Student”.

Adding Students to the Meal Application

Step 9: Enter student first name, last name, date of birth, school, and grade.

Note: You do not have to enter the Student ID to continue completing the meal application.

Select Yes or No if student is foster, homeless, migrant, runaway, or headstart.

Select Yes or No if student receives income.

After entering information for the student, click “Add this Student”.

Step 10: If there are more IDEA students in your household, click “Add a Student” again. Continue this process until you have added all students to the meal application.

After entering all students, click Next.



Declining Benefits

Step 11: If you wish to **DECLINE** benefits, check off box.

Note: Declining benefits means that your student will have a PAID status. Lunch meals will be charged to your student's account. You will be responsible for paying the student's account balance.

If you do not want to decline and wish to continue with applying for benefits, click Next.

Adding SNAP/TANF benefits to the application

Step 12: If you receive SNAP, TANF, or FDPIR benefits, click on YES.

Enter your 8 or 9 digit EDG#.

If you do not receive SNAP, TANF, or FDPIR benefits, click on NO.

Then click Next.

Entering household member information to the application

Step 13: You will now enter all members of your household. This includes all adults and any other children who were not added as students.

If the household member receives income, select Yes and enter amount and frequency of income.

If the household member does not receive income, select No.

After entering the name and income of the household member, click Add this Member.

Continue this process for each household member.

Step 14: After entering all household members, click Next.



Step 15: Review all information entered. If everything is correct, click Next.

Step 16: The questions found on the next screen are optional.

Answer the questions, if you would like and click Next.

If you do not want to answer, leave them blank and click Next.

Submitting the application

Step 17: If you have a SSN, click Yes and enter your SSN. If you do not have a SSN, click No.

Click “Sign” to electronically sign the application.

Click “Submit My Application”.

You are DONE! You have successfully submitted your student’s meal application.

Please allow 10 business days for application processing.
