

Child Nutrition Program January 2022 Harvest of the Month Recipe

Cheesy Kale & Veggie Quesadilla



Directions

- 1. In a medium skillet, heat 2 Tbsp. of olive oil.
- 2. Add peppers and onions to skillet. Cook until softened, about 3 minutes.
- 3. Add cumin, salt, pepper and garlic powder. Stir well and cook for another minute.
- 4. Add the torn kale leaves. Lower heat. Let Kale cook for 1-2 minutes, or until wilted and soft.
- 5. Remove pan from heat.
- 6. Heat griddle or large skillet to medium high heat. Drizzle 1 tsp olive oil on griddle or skillet.
- 7. Lower heat to low and [lace tortillas on griddle and let cook until golden brown. Flip over.
- Spread cheese evenly on half of the tortillas.
 Then spoon Kale and Veggie mixture on top of cheese. Top with remaining cheese and remaining tortillas.
- 9. Carefully flip tortillas over and ensure that both sides are golden brown. Remove from heat, and cut into quarters.

10. Enjoy!

Switch up your Taco Night with these Cheesy Kale & Veggie Quesadillas that are loaded with kale, veggies and cheddar cheese. Keep it gluten free and use corn tortillas instead of flour.

Ingredients

- 6 mini corn tortillas or 4 regular size corn tortillas
- 1.5 cups of kale leaves, torn into bite sized pieces
- 1 red bell pepper, diced
- 1 green bell pepper, diced
- 1/2 medium red onion, diced
- 1/4 tsp. cumin
- 1/2 tsp. salt
- 1/4 tsp. black pepper
- 1/4 tsp. garlic powder
- 3/4 cup of shredded cheddar cheese
- 2 Tbsp. olive oil (for veggies)
 1 tsp. olive oil (for tortillas)
- Optional:
- Serve with fresh limes, salsa or guacamole

Common Curly

This variety is usually available at the grocer store. It is great raw in salad, or smoothies or tru it sauteed or in soup.

Dinosaur

This is an Italian variety that was once grown by Thomas Jefferson! The leaves have a reptilian texture, which is where it gets its name.



Fast Facts

Kales is one of the healthiest and most nutritious plant foods in existence! It has more calcium than milk and more Vitamin C than an orange!

Some varieties of kale grow to be 5 to 7 feet tall!



Kales is one of the most versatile dark green veggies- try it in a smoothie, a salad, juiced, sauteed, or bake it and eat like chips!

The first mention of Kale in America was in 1669! But it has been around since about 2000 BC!


