POLICY GROUP 6 - SPECIAL EDUCATION
COORDINATION OF FUNDS TO PURCHASE INSTRUCTIONAL
MATERIALS

Instructional materials adopted by IDEA Public Schools must be provided to students at no cost.

If IDEA Public Schools chooses to coordinate with the National Instructional Materials Access Center (NIMAC) when purchasing print instructional materials, it must acquire the print instructional materials in the same manner and subject to the same conditions as the Texas Education Agency acquires print instructional materials.

If IDEA Public Schools chooses not to coordinate with the NIMAC when purchasing print instructional materials, it will provide instructional materials to blind persons or other persons with print disabilities in a timely manner and shall provide assurance of compliance with this policy to the Texas Education Agency.
