

Biennial Assessment

The School will inform the Parents of its Students and the public about their ability to access the data, questions, and assessment instruments required or used in the biennial assessment of the state's students pursuant to the National Assessment of Educational Progress Act, as amended by the No Child Left Behind Act (if applicable).

The School will inform the Parents of its Students selected to participate in the biennial assessment that their children may be excused from participating in the assessment for any reason. However, federal law also requires all states that receive Title I funds to participate in NAEP reading and mathematics assessments at fourth and eighth grades. Similarly, schools that receive Title I funds and are selected for the NAEP sample are also required to participate in NAEP reading and mathematics assessments at fourth and eighth grades.
