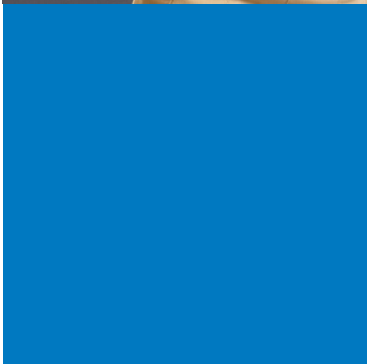
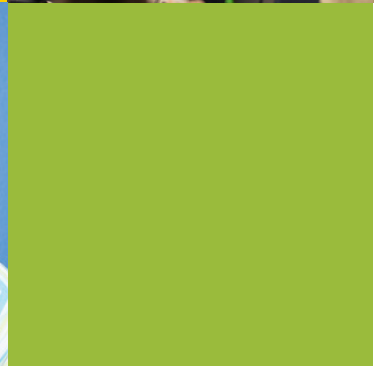

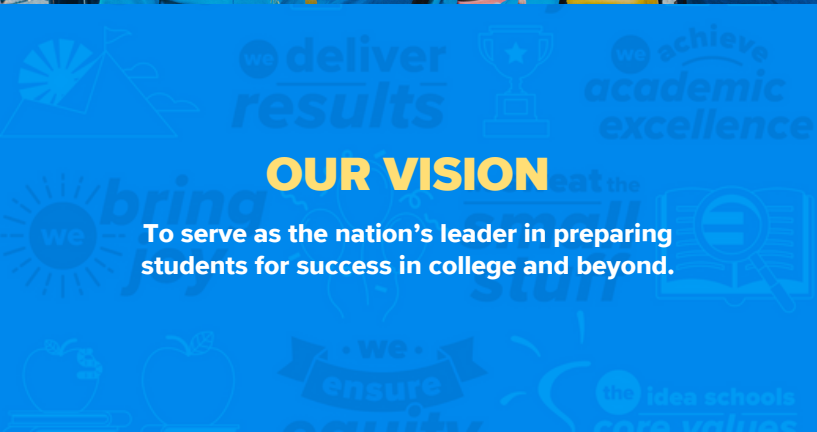
Dear IDEA Greater Cincinnati Families,
