

College, Career, and Military Ready (CCMR)

The purpose of CCMR is to measure graduates' preparedness for college, the workforce, or the military.

In order for the School/District to get credit for CCMR, the graduate must achieve one of the following:

- Meet Texas Success Initiative (TSI) Criteria in ELA/Reading and Mathematics
- Meet Criteria on Advanced Placement (AP)/International Baccalaureate (IB) Examination
- Earn Dual Course Credits
- Enlist in the Armed Forces
- Earn an Industry-Based Certification
- Earn an Associate's Degree
- CTE Coherent Sequence Coursework Aligned with Industry-Based Certifications

Math:

Logic: Goal to achieve is reaching 60% Meets in 3 years

Logic: Take result from prior year, subtract from 60, and close the gap 1/3 of the way to 60 for each year.

Logic: After 3 years, increase performance by 3%age points each year

Logic: The above logic does not apply to SpEd

Logic for Sped: The target for sped will be a 10pt differential compared to the ALL student target. Basically 10 points less than the ALL student target

Reading

Logic: Goal to achieve is reaching 60% Meets in 2 years

Logic: Take result from prior year, subtract from 60, and close the gap 1/2 of the way to 60 for each year.

Logic: After 2 years, increase performance by 3%age points each year

Logic: The above logic does not apply to SpEd

Logic for Sped: The target for sped will be a 10pt differential compared to the ALL student target. Basically 10 points less than the ALL student target
