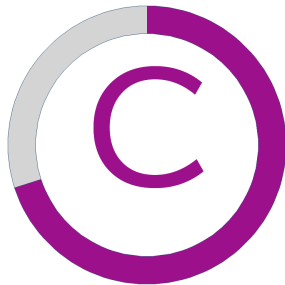

Overall Performance Details

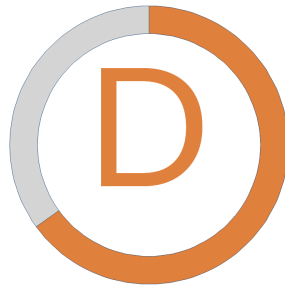

Overall Rating



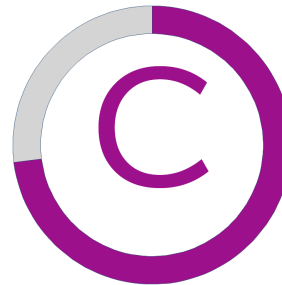

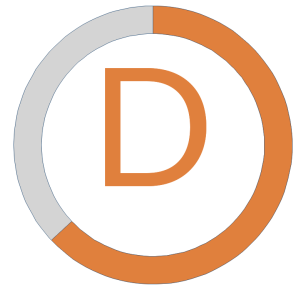
