The following vendor-submitted questions were received in response to the referenced solicitation. Responses are provided below for the benefit of all prospective respondents.

Question 1: If we were awarded in last year's RFQ, do we need to rebid on this RFQ?

Answer: No, as long as you have an active contract with IDEA, there is no need to submit another bid.

Question 2: When awarded the solicitation to provide services, who would be the contact within the district to inquire about open roles for professions related to the RFP?

Answer: We will provide that information once awarded.

Question 3: Is there a rate cap for each of the requested professions? If so, could the district please share the applicable rates

Answer: We don't have a rate cap, but expect the rates to be within the market rate.

Question 4: What is the anticipated number of openings by profession for services related to this bid?

Answer: At this time, we are uncertain about the specific services required for each campus. If awarded, the Regional Special Education Leader will contact you to outline the services needed. However, the details will not be clear until we approach the start of the next school year.

Question 5: We are seeking to understand how many vendor-supplied contractors (such as Speech-Language Pathologists, Occupational Therapists, Physical Therapists, etc.) are currently being provided to the District by other vendors.

Answer: Florida currently has 40+ vendors for Special Education Instruction and Related Services. For a more detailed breakdown, please reach out to information.request@ideapublicschools.org.

Question 6: Who are the current vendors, and what are their bill rates for requested services?

Answer: We are unable to share that information at the time, but you can email information.request@ideapublicschools.org for more information.

Question 7: Are the same services solicited in Ohio and Florida?

Answer: Yes, the only difference is the state requiring service.

Question 8: When providing staff resumes and certificates are we allowed to redact their names?

Answer: No, redacting the names is not allowed.

Question 9: What's the anticipated number of full-time positions you anticipate for each discipline?

Answer: At this time, we are uncertain about the specific services required for each campus. If awarded, the Regional Special Education Leader will contact you to outline the services needed. However, the details will not be clear until we approach the start of the next school year.

Question 10: On average, how many contractors have you utilized over the past three school years?

Answer: Over 100+ vendors.

Question 11: Please confirm vendor responses to the RFQ may be through EITHER Public Purchasing OR Hard Copy?

Answer: You may submit electronically via Public Purchase or you may submit a hard copy via mail.

Question 12: Can we select the job roles we want to bid for? If not all?

Answer: Yes, please indicate your response on Attachment G.

Question 13: Is pricing fee per service, or hourly that includes payment for paperwork time?

Answer: We typically see hourly rates per service.

Question 14: Is there an anticipated headcount for the job roles?

Answer: At this time, we are uncertain about the specific services required for each campus. If awarded, the Regional Special Education Leader will contact you to outline the services needed. However, the details will not be clear until we approach the start of the next school year.

Question 15: Do we need to resubmit for 26-27 SY if we were just awarded for 25-26

Answer: No, as long as you have an active contract with IDEA, there is no need to resubmit. However, if your scope of services has expanded and are not included in your current contract, please resubmit.

Question 16: Can you provide historical pricing and incumbent details?

Answer: We are unable to disclose that information at this moment, however, please feel free to reach out to information.request@ideapublicschools.org.

Question 17: Is this primarily/exclusively push-in staffing services or could prospective vendors operate a subset of classes/programming?

Answer: Both.

Question 18: Will IDEA Public Schools accept Docusign signatures in lieu of wet signatures?

Answer: Yes, IDEA will accept both.

Question 19: What is the anticipated number of full time and part time positions for each role?

Answer: At this time, we are uncertain about the specific services required for each campus. If awarded, the Regional Special Education Leader will contact you to outline the services needed. However, the details will not be clear until we approach the start of the next school year.

Question 20: Who are the current vendors providing services?

Answer: We are unable to share that information at the time, but you can email information.request@ideapublicschools.org for more information.

Question 21: Are your current vendors meeting your needs?

Answer: Yes.

Question 22: How long have the incumbent suppliers held this contract?

Answer: It varies from vendor to vendor. For previous RFQs, they've had a 3-year contract with an option for an additional two (2) one (1) year renewals. For this current RFQ, we are offering a one (1) year contract, with an additional four (4) year renewals.

Question 23: Will IDEA Public Schools utilize its own contract, the vendor's contract, or the RFP as the agreement?

Answer: IDEA will use its own contract (including the RFP), but a vendor can submit their own contract if they prefer.

Question 24: What are the current hourly bill rates for vendors providing similar services?

Answer: We are unable to share that information at the time, but you can email information.request@ideapublicschools.org for more information.

Question 25: Does IDEA Public Schools have a cap on the hourly rate for these services?

Answer: We don't have a rate cap, but expect the rates to be within the market rate.

Question 26: Will IDEA Public Schools accept a rate range or a flat rate (i.e. - \$75-80/hr. versus \$75/hr.)

Answer: IDEA prefers a flat rate.

Question 27: Do you require resumes and license verifications of potential contracted candidates to be included in our submission?

a) If so, can we provide sample resumes with personal information redacted?

Answer: Yes, resumes and license verifications of potential candidates are required. Personal information cannot be redacted.

Question 28: How will the vendors be notified of an award?

Answer: They will be notified via email.

Question 29: Do you anticipate awarding one or multiple vendors?

Answer: It depends on how many submissions we get, but more than likely multiple vendors.

Question 30: Is the vendor expected to have a clinic or local office?

Answer: No.

Question 31: Will assigned candidates have access to materials, supplies, equipment, evaluation kits, and protocols provided by your schools?

Answer: No.

Question 32: Will assigned candidates have access to computers/laptops and printers?

Answer: No.

Question 33: Will IDEA Public Schools reimburse for mileage traveled between school campuses on the same day?

Answer: IDEA will not reimburse for mileage.

Question 34: Are clinicians required to directly bill Medicaid for reimbursement or do they just complete paperwork for IDEA Public Schools to submit to Medicaid for reimbursement?

Answer: Clinicians complete paperwork for Idea and will not independently submit for Medicaid reimbursement. They will still need an NPI number for the IDEA to bill.

Question 35: Is IDEA Public Schools open to utilizing Clinical Fellows? If so, are we required to provide supervision?

Answer: We accept Clinical Fellows and can typically find supervision.

Question 36: Will IDEA Public Schools accept and consider submissions from staffing agencies?

Answer: Yes.

Question 37: Is IDEA Public Schools open to the using teletherapy?

Answer: Yes.

Question 38: Would you allow supervision of RBTs from a School Psych, SW, or LCSW?

Answer: No.

Question 39: Can you provide the name and contact information for the individual who will be coordinating these services at your district?

Answer: We will provide that information once awarded.

Question 40: Would IDEA Public Schools consider the utilization of a Managed Services Provider (MSP) to manage and stabilize your vendors and competing rates across all contracts for this opportunity?

Answer: No.

Question 41: Will IDEA allow a piggybacking arrangement from your RFP award RFQ#30-SPED-0625 in TX for your Florida staffing needs?

Answer: No, RFQ #30-SPED-0625 Texas only applies to Texas.

Question 42: Can the district clarify the anticipated number of positions by discipline (e.g., School Psychologist, SLP, OT, etc) for the initial contract term?

Answer: At this time, we are uncertain about the specific services required for each campus. If awarded, the Regional Special Education Leader will contact you to outline the services needed. However, the details will not be clear until we approach the start of the next school year.

Question 43: Are these positions primarily in-person, virtual/teletherapy, or hybrid?

Answer: In person.

Question 44: Can the district provide average and maximum caseload expectations by discipline?

Answer: At this time, we are uncertain about the specific services required for each campus. If awarded, the Regional Special Education Leader will contact you to outline the services needed. However, the details will not be clear until we approach the start of the next school year.

Question 45: Are contractors responsible for completing initial evaluations, re-evaluations, or both?

Answer: Yes.

Question 46: What documentation platform does the district utilize (e.g., IEP management system), and will access/training be provided?

Answer: V3 Frontline/ESPED and access/training will be provided.

Question 47: Are contractors required to attend staff meetings, professional development, or district trainings?

Answer: Contractors may be asked to attend meetings.

Question 48: What is the anticipated start date for the majority of positions?

Answer: Beginning of school year. It varies per region.

Question 49: Is the contract based on a 10-month school calendar, a 12-month calendar, or variable based on role?

Answer: Varies by role.

Question 50: Are extended school year (ESY) services included in this RFP?

Answer: Yes.

Question 51: How are school holidays, teacher workdays, and student non-contact days handled for contractor billing?

Answer: They may bill for documentation potentially, but would have to have approval from IDEA's Regional Programs Director.

Question 52: What are the district's background screening and fingerprinting requirements, and what is the estimated processing timeline?

Answer:

Florida:

Background Screening: Florida Law, the Jessica Lunsford Act, requires a vendor who will have employees in direct contact with students or present on charter school property to undergo a Level II background screening, which consists of an FDLE/FBI search if vendor representatives will be at a school when students are present, have direct contact with students, or have access to or control of school funds. If no personnel will meet any of the three criteria, the law does not apply and no action will be needed. Each vendor will be required, at its own cost, to comply with the background screening and badging requirements prior to providing services and provide proof of compliance.

Question 53: Who will provide day-to-day supervision for contracted staff?

Answer: It varies by position.

Question 54: What is the district's performance evaluation process for contracted providers?

Answer: It varies by position.

Question 55: Are minimum weekly hour guarantees required?

Answer: No.

Question 56: What is the district's standard payment timeline (e.g., Net 30, Net 45)?

Answer: Net 30.

Question 57: Are rate adjustments permitted during the contract term due to inflation or market changes?

Answer: No.

Question 58: Will travel between multiple school sites be reimbursed?

Answer: IDEA will not reimburse for mileage.

Question 59: Does the district anticipate awarding to a single vendor or multiple vendors?

Answer: It depends on how many submissions we get, but more than likely multiple vendors.

Question 60: If multiple vendors are awarded, how will assignments be distributed (e.g., rotation, best value, first-come submission)?

Answer: First available.

Question 61: Are there incumbent contractors currently serving in these roles?

Answer: It depends on the region.

Question 62: Is the contracted agency responsible for providing orientation to the skilled nursing staff, or will the school/district orient new nurse staff provided by agencies?

Answer: The school/district will orient.

Question 63: Will the district school nurse oversee the physician-directed orders for the student, or will this be a requirement of the contracted agency?

Answer: It depends on the region.

Question 64: Will the contracted skilled nursing staff document care for the student on forms provided by the school/district?

Answer: Yes.

Question 65: Is there any expectation for the contracted agency to provide supervision of the contracted school nursing staff? If yes, how often?

Answer: No.

Question 66: Is there a district school nurse who would oversee all contracted nurses?

Answer: Regional nurses support contract nurses.

Question 67: Would you be open to accepting LPNs for 1:1 Skilled Nursing needs?

Answer: Yes.

Question 68: Would you be open to accepting RNs for 1:1 Skilled Nursing needs who do not have their BSN?

Answer: Yes.

Question 69: Will you accept vendors who cannot provide all of the modalities listed in the solicitation but can provide 2-3 of the services?

Answer: Yes.

Question 70: Can you please provide us with a sample contract so we can review the terms and conditions?

Answer: Yes. Also please read the terms and conditions stated in the RFQ as those will apply as well.

Question 71: How many Nurses do you anticipate needing in the 2026 and 2027 school year?

Answer: At this time, we are uncertain about the specific services required for each campus. If awarded, the Regional Special Education Leader will contact you to outline the services needed. However, the details will not be clear until we approach the start of the next school year.

Question 72: How many RBTs do you anticipate needing in the 2026 and 2027 school year?

Answer: At this time, we are uncertain about the specific services required for each campus. If awarded, the Regional Special Education Leader will contact you to outline the services needed. However, the details will not be clear until we approach the start of the next school year.

Question 73: Can the district please explain how contract needs will be disseminated to awarded vendors post-implementation?

Answer: Special Education Regional Leaders will contact the vendors with their specific needs.

Question 74: Can the district please state the date the RFP would be awarded on and in what capacity (Email, Letter, Phone)?

Answer: Vendor(s) will be awarded via email and letter. We are unsure on what specific date but should be after evaluations take place.

Question 75: Typically, how many students are paired with a Registered Behavioral Technician?

Answer: Typically, 1-4 students.

Question 76: What are you looking for when it comes to tracking academic progress?

Answer: It depends on the position and region, but typically internal exams or a CBM.

Question 77: Will our Registered Behavioral Technicians and BCBAs be utilizing the school's system of record for documenting their time and all clinical documentation?

Answer: Yes.

Question 78: Will any RBTs provided to the school be required to be supervised by our BCBAs or does the school have BCBAs on staff to provide supervision?

Answer: It depends on the region.

Question 79: Will the school provide the credentialed teacher and the curriculum, which the contracted agency would provide behavior team members to support?

Answer: IDEA provides a credentialed teacher and curriculum.

Question 80: Will the contracted agency be drafting the BIPs and goals, or will the district BCBA develop the items that the behavior contracted employees will be implementing

Answer: It depends on the region.

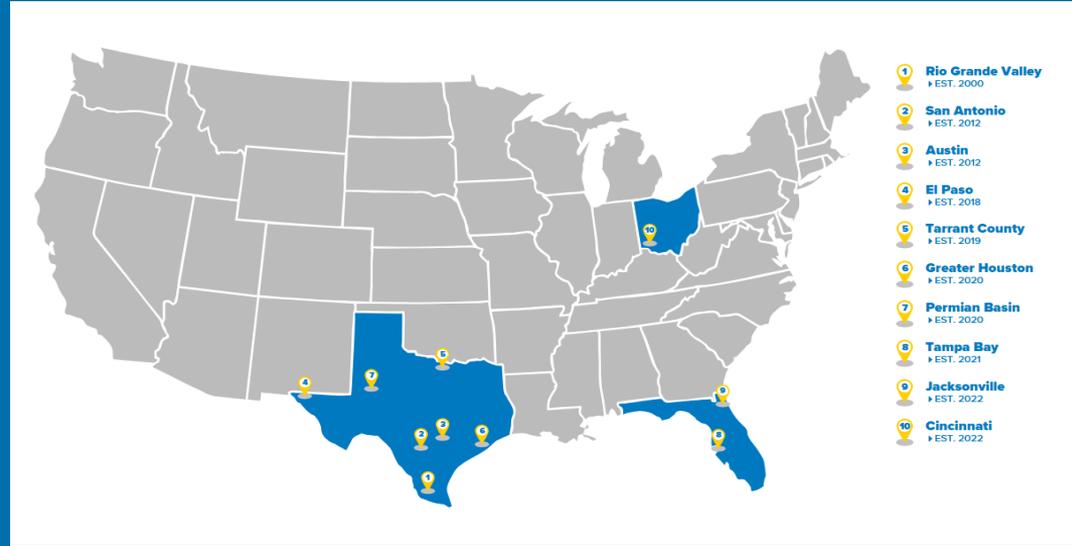
