WHEREAS the Board recognizes that due to inclement weather on and about June 15, 2026, in the IDEA San Antonio Region; and on and about June 16, 2026, in the IDEA Rio Grande Valley region, was an unforeseen and unavoidable emergency of urgent public necessity; and

WHEREAS, the Board has a substantial public interest to protect the health and safety of its students, staff, their families and community; and

WHEREAS, due to INCLEMENT WEATHER the following IDEA Public Schools regions closed operations on and about June 15, 2026, in the IDEA San Antonio region; and on and about June 16, 2026, in the IDEA Rio Grande Valley region; in order to ensure the safety of its students and staff; and

WHEREAS, no makeup days will be necessary for instruction for IDEA San Antonio or IDEA Rio Grande Valley regions; and

WHEREAS the Board of Directors of IDEA Public Schools desires to ensure continuity in regular pay for regular duty schedule during the closure, pursuant to Board Policy regarding Compensation During Closure;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Directors of IDEA Public Schools, at a lawfully called meeting of the Board, held in compliance with the Texas Open Meetings Act, do hereby adopt the following Resolutions:

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED THAT:

1. The Board authorizes the Superintendent to compensate IDEA San Antonio employees for their regular duty schedule for June 15, 2026.
2. The Board authorizes the Superintendent to compensate IDEA Rio Grande Valley employees for their regular duty schedule for June 16, 2026.

**BOARD RESOLUTION
OF
IDEA PUBLIC SCHOOLS**

WHEREAS the highest aim of the Board of Directors of IDEA PUBLIC SCHOOLS is to ensure the physical safety of students enrolled in and staff employed by IDEA Public Schools; and

WHEREAS the Board, in consultation with the Superintendent and the IDEA Public Schools' legal counsel, have considered options under federal and state law for the placement of competent and qualified armed security personnel at its campuses; and

WHEREAS the Board endeavors to prevent any physical injury or loss of life resulting from an active shooter incident or similar tragedy such as recently experienced in public schools, hospitals, and churches within the State of Texas and beyond; and

WHEREAS Texas Education Code section 37.0814 requires an armed security officer during regular school hours at each IDEA Public School campus; and

WHEREAS the Board is authorized by Texas Education Code sections 12.107 and 45.105 to expend funds for purposes necessary in the conduct of the public schools as determined by the Board; and

WHEREAS the Board may authorize an individual to carry firearms and handguns on school premises in accordance with written regulations or written authorization under Texas Penal Code section 46.03(a)(1)(A); and

WHEREAS IDEA Public Schools has already partnered with local agencies and a licensed security company; and

WHEREAS the Board of Directors has determined that the expense for security including armed security personnel is necessary in the conduct of the public schools for the hardening of the public schools within its jurisdiction for the protection of human life; and

WHEREAS the Board has determined that there is a lack of availability of qualified personnel in the workforce to serve as a school district peace officer, school resource officer, or a commissioned peace officer within its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS the Board desires that the IDEA Public Schools continue to pursue and make effort to employ armed security personnel to provide adequate coverage for its campuses, but given the difficulties in staffing such positions, the Board must necessarily claim a good cause exception to the requirement that each campus have an armed security officer during regular school hours as provided under the new Texas Education Code section 37.0814(c) due to the unavailability of funding and/or unavailability of personnel who qualify as a school district peace officer, school resource officer, or a commissioned peace officer employed as security personnel; and

WHEREAS Texas Education Code section 37.814(d) would require IDEA Public Schools to develop an alternative standard with which it is able to comply; and

WHEREAS IDEA Public Schools has implemented various safety measures designed to prevent physical injury or loss of life resulting from an active shooter incident or similar tragedy including a Multi-Hazard Emergency Operations Plan (“MEOP”) addressing prevention, mitigation, preparedness, response, and recovery as defined by the Texas School Safety Center; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Directors of IDEA PUBLIC SCHOOLS, at a lawfully called meeting of the Board, held in compliance with the Texas Open Meetings Act, do hereby adopt the following Resolutions:

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED THAT:

- Designated Security Personnel are authorized to possess firearms and handguns on IDEA Public Schools campuses in a manner consistent with their professional license and certifications as issued by the Texas Department of Public Safety, the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement, or other licensing agency or authority
- IDEA Public Schools is authorized and shall continue the engagement of a security personnel company to provide armed security officers for the campuses;
- IDEA Public Schools is authorized to enter into interlocal agreements with local law enforcement agencies under Govt. Code Chapter 791 to provide school resource officers and other law enforcement support for campuses;
- The Superintendent, or designee, shall continue their efforts to secure additional funding and to source, hire, employ or contract with security personnel for the campuses;
- The Superintendent, or designee, shall oversee the staffing and planning/scheduling for security personnel covering the IDEA Public Schools’ campuses;
- The Superintendent, or designee, shall work with the Regional Education Service Center and Texas School Safety Center to continue pursuit of additional resources, training and safety and security policies, procedures and practices;
- The Superintendent, or designee, is authorized to prepare and maintain documentation of IDEA Public Schools’ good cause exception.
