To: All Prospective Vendors

The following vendor-submitted questions were received in response to the referenced solicitation. Responses are provided below for the benefit of all prospective respondents.

Question 1: Are you all looking for one Vendor to cover all states, or are you looking for individual vendors per RFP?

Answer: Each RFP and its associated FCC Form 470 has been posted separately and is available to all prospective bidders. Offerors may choose to respond to any or all of the RFPs. Each proposal will be evaluated separately, in accordance with the evaluation criteria published in the applicable RFP, and awards will be made in accordance with the terms of each RFP.

Question 2: May content filtering and GenAI risk controls be included within a unified subscription if the proposal separately itemizes E-Rate eligible and ineligible costs?

Answer: Yes, the bidder can provide e-rate eligible cost and separate line items.

Question 3: May the respondent use manufacturer-led implementation and 24x7 support while remaining the prime contractor and SPI-billing service provider?

Answer: Yes.

Question 4: May manufacturer or implementation-partner K-12 references satisfy the reference requirement for a newly authorized reseller?

Answer: Manufacturer or implementation-partner references may be included as supplemental information; however, references submitted to satisfy the reference

requirement should demonstrate the Respondent's own past performance, reliability, and relevant experience.

Question 5: Attachment C requires evidence of insurance with the proposal. Will a carrier-issued binder or certificate showing coverage effective before contract performance satisfy this requirement?

Answer: Yes, it satisfies this requirement.

Question 6: Must one proposal cover every pricing line, or may a respondent mark an individual add-on "No Bid" as contemplated by the pricing instructions?

Answer: No, the bidder must be able to supply all line items.

Question 7: Could you please confirm whether submitting through a single method is sufficient? Specifically, if we submit our proposal through the Public Purchase portal, would that satisfy the submission requirements, or is a hard-copy submission also required in addition to the portal submission?

Answer: Submitting via a single method is sufficient. Either via Public Purchase, via mail to our Headquarters address or via Tyler Munis Self Service (Texas Only).

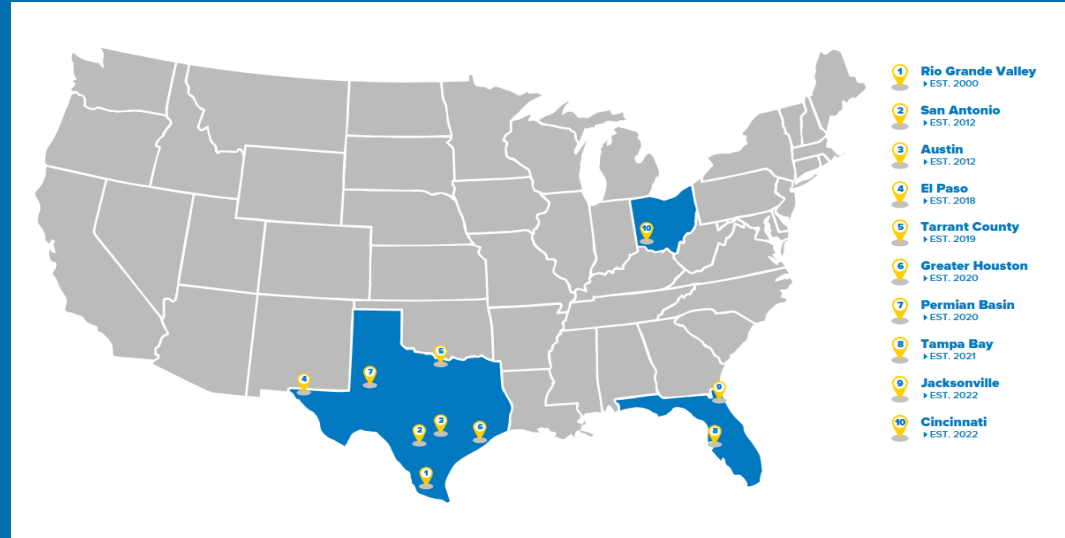

IDEA Public Schools, IDEA Florida, Inc., and IDEA Greater Cincinnati, Inc. ("IDEA") is issuing this Request for Proposal ("RFP") to solicit proposals from qualified vendor(s) to provide a **Firewall as a Service (FWaaS)** cloud-based solution. The selected vendor(s) shall furnish all required licensing, implementation, configuration, support, maintenance, and related services necessary to provide a fully operational solution for the E-Rate funding period.

The proposed solution must support a **Zero Trust Architecture** that aligns with the principles outlined in [NIST Special Publication 800-207](#), or an equivalent industry-recognized framework. The new service is anticipated to commence on **July 1, 2027**, upon the expiration of IDEA's current service agreement and/or implementation of the newly awarded solution.

Cost of E-Rate Eligible Products and/or Services	30	Respondent's proposed price of E-Rate eligible products and/or services.
Technical & Functional Suitability	28	The extent to which the proposed goods or services meet IDEA's needs. This includes, but is not limited to technical specifications, functional requirements, and service expectations as outlined in the RFP.
Reputation & Reliability	12	Respondent's demonstrated reliability and reputation as evidenced by past performance, industry references, third-party evaluations, overall standing in the marketplace, and previous working relationship with other K-12 public charter schools.
Total Cost of Ownership	10	Total long-term cost to acquire the Respondent's goods and/or services. This includes the total ineligible cost to IDEA for acquiring and maintaining the proposed goods and/or services throughout the full duration of the agreement.
Terms & Conditions	10	Respondent's proposed contract terms and conditions.
Completeness of Proposal	5	Evaluators will ensure that all required elements of the proposal have been included and meet the specified submission guidelines.
Service Response & Support Capability	5	Evaluation will be based on the Respondent's demonstrated ability to provide timely support, troubleshooting, and onsite technical assistance. Respondents must submit a service response plan detailing response times, escalation procedures, and support resources.
